- Founded in 1998, Incorporated in 2002
- Not-for-profit, tax exempt 501(c) (3) organization
- Provides support, education and resources for individuals and families impacted by autism. Served 2000 individuals with autism and families in 2023!
- Purchased \$1.3M Building in 2022
- Spectrum Autism Support Center Opened September 2023
- Offers support group meetings, respite, camps, social skills groups, family events and community education and training

EVENTS AND PROGRAMMING

Monthly Meetings



Spectrum hosted **10** monthly meetings, and served 529 parents and family members.

Drama Club



38 individuals participated in an inclusive drama program: 18 in Lion King Jr. and 20 preparing for Willy Wonka Jr. production.

Mocha Matters



Spectrum's virtual support group served 105 people of color who have family members with autism.

Family Events



Spectrum had 3710 people attended 7 family events: Georgia Race for Autism & Fall Festival, Gladiators Family Game Day, Egg Hunt, Pool Party, Mom's Day Out, Family Fishing Day, Holiday Party

Respite



Spectrum provided respite programs for 260 individuals ages 5-18.

Camps



Spectrum hosted day and family camps for **706** individuals.

Partners Support Adult Social Support



Neurodiverse Partner Support group offered virtually twice a month. 550 individuals were served worldwide.

Provided 10 opportunities serving 717 individuals autism. (Monthly Co-ed support, Co-ed social outing, 2 virtual for women only, Women's ArtReach, Table Talk and Saturday Social Club)


