- Founded in 1998, Incorporated in 2002
- Not-for-profit, tax exempt 501(c) (3) organization
- Provides support, education and resources for individuals and families impacted by autism. Served 2000 individuals with autism and families in 2024!

- Spectrum Autism Support Center Opened September 2023
- Offers support group meetings, respite, camps, social skills groups, family events and community education and training

# EVENTS AND PROGRAMMING

### **Monthly Meetings**



Spectrum hosted **21** monthly meetings, and served **733** parents and family members.

#### **Drama Club**



44 individuals participated in an inclusive drama program:20 in Willy Wonka Jr. and 24 preparing for Aladdin Jr. production.

#### **Mocha Matters**



Spectrum's virtual support group served **138** people of color who have family members with autism.

#### **Family Events**



Spectrum had **3700** people attend 7 family events: Georgia Race for Autism & Fall Festival, Cornhole for a Cause, Egg Hunt, Pool Party, Mom's Day Out, Family Fishing Day, Holiday Party

#### **Respite**



Spectrum provided respite programs for **207** individuals ages 5-18.

#### **Camps**



Spectrum hosted day and family camps for **601** individuals.

### Partners Support Adult/Teen Social Support



Neurodiverse Partner Support group offered virtually twice a month. **476** individuals were served worldwide.



Provided **10** opportunities serving **750** individuals autism. (Monthly Co-ed support, Co-ed social outing, 2 virtual for women only, Women's Art Reach, Table Talk and Saturday Social Club)
